



Privacy Policy

Connecticut statutes require that Stone Academy protect the personal information of its students and employees. The statute defines personal information as any information that associates a particular individual with a unique identifier, including a Social Security number, a driver's license number, a state identification card number, an account number, a credit card or debit card number, an alien registration number, or a health insurance identification number. Personal information does not include information that is lawfully available to the general public from government records or widely distributed media.

We are required to do the following:

- 1) protect the confidentiality of Social Security numbers
- 2) prohibit unlawful disclosure of Social Security numbers
- 3) limit access to Social Security numbers

Stone Academy does not use the Social Security numbers of its students or employees as any type of ID number. Any time the number is transmitted electronically it is done so via a secured network that utilizes encryption software. Access to anyone's number is limited via the use of password systems and / or locked filing cabinets. Employees with such access are trained in the importance of confidentiality.
